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Jelly Roll Log Cabin

Fabrics Required:

½ yd. for center

28 dark 2 ½" jelly roll strips

36 light 2 ½" jelly roll strips

½ yd. for Inner Border

1 ¼ yds. for Outer Border

5/8 yd. for Binding

5 ½ yds. for Backing

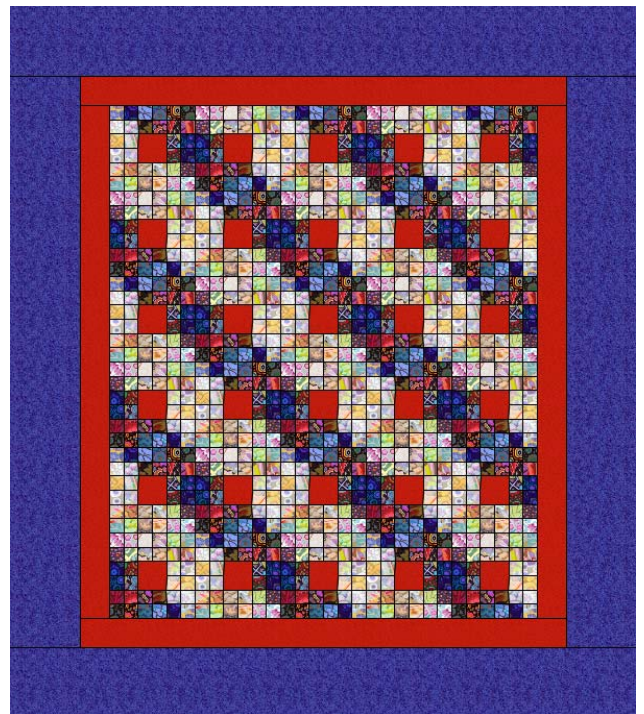
Use ¼" seam allowances throughout quilt.

You will be making strip sets using your pre-cut jelly roll strips. They make construction of this quilt a real timesaver.

Choose random strips of darks and make 2 each of the following sets:



Cut strip sets apart into 2 ½" pieces.

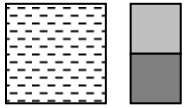


Choose random strips of lights and make 2 each of the following sets:

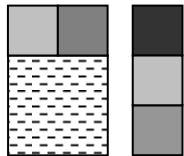


Center: Cut (4) 4 ½" x WOF strips (*WOF = width of fabric from selvage to selvage*)
-Cut into (30) 4 ½" squares

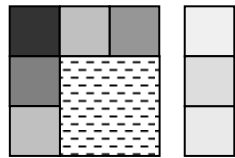
You will use 1 piece from each strip set per block. You get 16 pieces per strip set = 16 blocks. Our design needed 30 blocks, so 2 strip sets are needed. You can use this information should you decide to make your quilt larger or smaller.



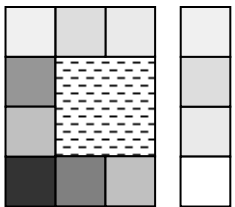
Beginning with your center square, stitch a dark 2 piece strip to the right side. Press toward darks.



Turn block ¼ turn and with strip you just sewed on top, stitch a dark 3 piece strip to the right side, matching seams. Press toward dark.



Turn block ¼ turn and stitch a light 3 piece strip to right side, matching seams. Press toward lights.



Turn block ¼ turn and stitch a light 4 piece strip to right side, matching seams. Press toward lights.

Turn block ¼ turn and stitch a 4 piece dark strip to the right side. Press. Continue by turning block ¼ turn and stitching another dark strip to right side (5 piece).

Turn block ¼ turn and stitch a 5 piece light to the right side. Press. Turn block ¼ turn and stitch a 6 piece light to right side. Press. Your block is now complete. Unfinished block should measure 12 ½" square.

Lay completed blocks out in a pleasing pattern. Stitch blocks together in horizontal rows and press. Stitch rows together, matching seams. Press.

Inner Border: Cut (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Stitch all strips together, end to end, to make one long strip. Measure top and bottom of quilt. Get a common number and cut 2 strips to that length. Stitch to top and bottom of quilt. Press. Repeat for left and right sides.

Outer Border: Cut (8) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Repeat as above.

Layer pieced top with batting and backing and quilt as desired.

The same quilt can be constructed using the Honey Bun (1 ½") rolls. Your finished block will measure 6 ½" square unfinished.
